- Trust Land Money Discussion: Davis School District has encouraged elementary schools to focus on goals that include reading (DIBELS) and mathematics. Trust Land Money will be used to work on and achieve the goals. Proposed goals are as follows:

Goal 1 (Reading):

At the beginning of the school year (2021-2022) focus on the at-risk students who tested within the at-risk range on the DIBELS test. Between the BOY (beginning of year) and MOY (middle of year) decrease the at-risk students by 50%. Next focus on remaining 50% and help them to achieve proficiency by the EOY (end of year). Data tracking will be used on students who have been in Lincoln the entire school year. While doing this focus will not be lost on the students who are proficient and even above grade level. They will continue to progress. It was proposed that TLM be used to pay for additional reading tutors.

<u>Goal 2 (Mathematics):</u>

Student will be tested BOY, MOY, and EOY to measure growth throughout the school year (2021-2022). Goal is to achieve 60% efficiency. The same group of students will be followed throughout the school year. Focus will be on PLC work and common assessments. Testing will be done using Benchmark Testing, it will give us better data.
